



The Spring Chicken Kids' Consignment Sale

Consignor Agreement

Merchandise:

Consignor agrees to the quality requirements set forth on the Spring Chicken Kids' Consignment Sale website including, but not limited to the following:

- i. Car seats are less than five years old, has all of its parts, never been in an accident, and is not on a recall list.
- ii. No consigned items are on a recall list. I've checked the list at: <http://www.cpsc.gov/>
- iii. All toys/games are in good working order with all pieces. If batteries are necessary for operation, they are included.

Consignor agrees to comply with the list of unacceptable items, per www.springchickensale.com and understands that items checked into the sale that do not meet our criteria will be removed from the sales floor. No pack and plays, cribs, wooden or metal painted toys, children's' jewelry or other items prohibited by the CPSIA act are being consigned.

The Spring Chicken Kids' Consignment Sale (hereafter called "SCKCS"), the lessors of the space where sale is held, any volunteer or paid participants of the sale *shall not be responsible for any theft, loss of or damage to merchandise while it is under their control.* Consignor assumes the risks of these events occurring by participating in the sale.

Consignor or Volunteer agrees to waive any and all claims for personal injury resulting from participation in the sale from whatever cause against SCKCS.

Sale of Merchandise:

Consignor agrees to allow SCKCS to sell any or all items checked into a SCKCS.

The Consignor is responsible for setting the selling price.

SCKCS shall not be responsible for unsold items due to missing or stolen tags.

If price is not specified on an item's tag, SCKCS reserves the right to fix the price and sell such item.

The Consignor agrees to have white tagged merchandise sold for half price during the last two hours of the sale.

Compensation:

SCKCS agrees to pay Consignor a percentage of the total sales amount for their items unless otherwise agreed upon prior to the sale. Standard is 50%. 60% if you are volunteering one shift or 70% if you are volunteering two shifts. If I have agreed to volunteer in exchange for a higher consignment percentage, and I do not complete my agreed upon hours as determined by the volunteer coordinator of the sale, my consignment percentage will be reduced to 50%.

As soon as practical after the sale, SCKCS shall remit to consignor net sales in accordance with above percentage.

Consignor gives consent to SCKCS to take possession of any items not picked up by the end of the designated pick-up period: 4:15-5:15 Sat. August 28.. Items tagged with a white tag will be offered to a non-profit charity.
